For many of you this may be the first time you or your child is taking part in an Outward Bound course. This document contains all of the essential information you will need in order to prepare to get the most out of the course, but in case you need to know more please do not hesitate to contact us.

WHO WE ARE

Outward Bound Oman/Tahaddi (see www.outwardboundoman.com) is a not for profit, educational organisation that inspires people to fulfill their potential through challenging outdoor experiences, raising self-esteem, developing personal skills and creating effective teams and leaders, so enabling people to face the future with confidence.

Founded in 1941, today there are Outward Bound schools operating in thirty countries and six continents worldwide, and over 200,000 people take part on an Outward Bound course each year. Outward Bound Oman/Tahaddi is the first Outward Bound school in the Arab World, something that reflects the forward thinking vision of His Majesty's government as it strives to develop the human potential of Oman.

Outward Bound Oman/Tahaddi uses the desert, mountains and sea as an outdoor classroom to enable people to return to the classroom or enter the workplace with the skills required to succeed. It works in close partnership with schools and employers to develop courses that expand people's horizons and give them the confidence to achieve things they never thought possible, developing essential life skills such as collective responsibility, teamwork and respect for others. Outward Bound Oman helps develop the skills employers seek when recruiting and training young people.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NEXT

This pack includes all the essential information you will need in order to get your child organised, and to make sure they arrive ready to learn.

There are three forms that must be completed by all participants – the forms can be located on the Outward Bound Oman website www.outwardboundoman.com ; click on Youth/Downloads

- 1. Enrolment form**
- 2. Medical information form**
- 3. Consent form**

Please complete these forms and return them to the organizing member of staff by the specified date.

Everyone who attends our courses must complete these forms accurately and with up-to-date information. All medical information will be treated in strictest confidence. For participants on medication, please remember to include this on the form and to ensure that they have their medication with them on arrival. All of our instructional staff are qualified in first aid.

EQUIPMENT - WHAT TO BRING, AND HOW TO PACK

We will provide participants with sleeping bags, sleeping mats, rucksacks, waterproof jackets, fleece tops and tents.

Participants need to bring personal clothing, and you will find an equipment/kit list on the youth/downloads section of the Outward Bound Oman website to help you pack.

HOW TO PACK

You are only away from home for a very short time. Bring the minimum, in one small bag. Only bring what is really essential. You will be given a backpack when the course begins, and your small bag will be stored in the back of an Outward Bound vehicle.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Our request is for you to leave valuable watches, jewellery, iPods and music players at home. Knives of any sort, and matches/lighters are prohibited. Mobile phones will be collected from participants at the start of the course, and returned at the end.

MONEY

Participants do not need to bring any money, as all our courses are fully inclusive. If you do choose to bring money, it only needs to be a very small amount, and Outward Bound Oman cannot be responsible for it.

SAFETY

The safety of our course participants is of paramount importance to us. We have been welcoming people on our courses and accompanying them on adventurous journeys in the wild for over 70 years. As a result, we have accumulated considerable experience in managing all aspects of safety and enjoy an enviable record in this area.

SMOKING AND ALCOHOL USAGE

Smoking is actively discouraged. If you insist on smoking, and are legally old enough to smoke, please ask your instructor where and when it is acceptable to do so. Smoking is not permitted in Outward Bound vehicles or tents at any time.

In addition, consumption of alcohol during an Outward Bound course is banned.

INSURANCE

Outward Bound Oman (UK) has full public liability insurance cover. All insurance cover we hold is restricted to the territorial area of the Sultanate of Oman; groups and participants coming from outside of Oman are advised to ensure they have their own insurance cover in place that includes cover for repatriation and medical treatment in case of emergency.

CONTACTING COURSE PARTICIPANTS

If a real emergency arises and you need to contact a participant during a course, you can do this in two ways; during the Oman working week (Saturday to Wednesday, 0800 – 1600hrs) you can contact the office on **00 968 24539788**. Outside of that time, you can contact the out of hours emergency number **00 968 99338734**. As our courses run in wilderness areas there is often no mobile signal, and contacting the group may take several hours. If there is an emergency on the course, our instructors carry Thuraya satellite phones and can contact you that way.

Please only do this in the case of a real emergency situation

OUR EXPECTATIONS

The participants lucky enough to be chosen to go on the course are representing their community. Our experience is that participant behaviour on courses is excellent, but to make sure you know what to expect, it is worth you reading these simple expectations before you come on the course;

- Participants must follow the requests and safety advice of Outward Bound Oman staff at all times.
- Any participant who behaves in a way that has a negative impact on the safety of other participants, or who fails to observe the requests and advice of Outward Bound staff, will be withdrawn from the course.
